- 4. experience on building construction projects, Tenderers are required to submit certified forms of contract for awarded contracts in the past, Taking Over and Completion Certificates dully certified together with Telephone Number and E-mail Addresses of the previous Employer/Awarding Agency. Tenderers should also note that the works must be completed within Fifteen (15) months inclusive of mobilization period and that they are required to deploy for the timely completion of the works. Tenderers who are proven non-performers need not apply as they will be disqualified.

Payment should will be made after Getting a Bill of Payment through TANePS.
- 7. Tenders shall be valid for a period of 120 days after Tender opening, and must be accompanied by a Tender Securing Declaration, and the tender must be submitted or be sent through www.taneps.go.tz
- 8. All Tenders in one original plus three copies properly filled in, and enclosed in plain envelopes must be delivered through TANePS before 13:30 Hours local time on 31st August, 2021. Tenders will be opened promptly thereafter in the presence of Tenderers' representatives who choose to attend in the opening through TANePS
- Late Tenders, portion of Tenders, Tenders not received, Tenders not opened at the Tender
 opening ceremony shall not be accepted for evaluation irrespective of the circumstances.
